

Instructions for assembling under a petition.

Contrary to popular belief, the First Amendment right to 'peaceable assembly' does not apply to any situation wherein the peace is actively being breached or commerce is being obstructed. breach of the peace and Rioting is still a crime.

The petition is the means by which the "silent majority" peaceably assembles under a single voice and subsequently ends their silence.

The petition should clearly state the grievance which the people are addressing and any proposed sanctions that may be imposed, should the grievance be ignored.

Petitions should be confined to grievances which effect the entire nation and should not propose unwarranted powers to be granted to the government.

As for where to send a petition, it should be sent to the governor of the respective state via Certified mail, return receipt requested.
